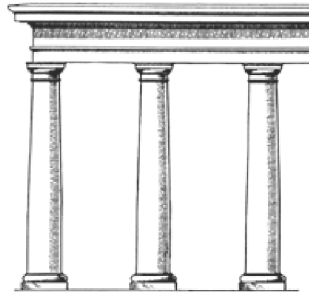
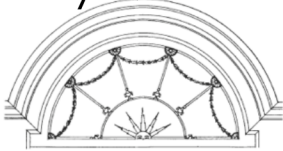

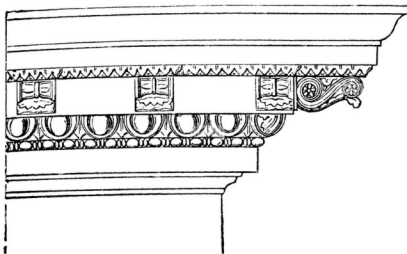
Can you find these architectural elements around Baltimore?

fan light: a semi-circular window usually over a door

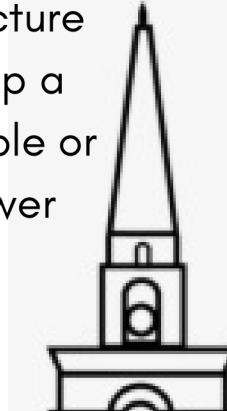


colonnade: a series of regularly spaced columns

cornice: the horizontal decoration at the top of a building or where the wall meets the ceiling



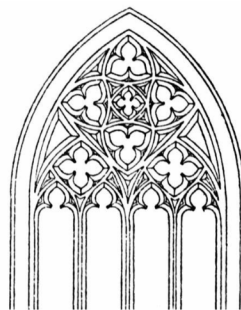
spire: a tall, pointy structure atop a steeple or tower



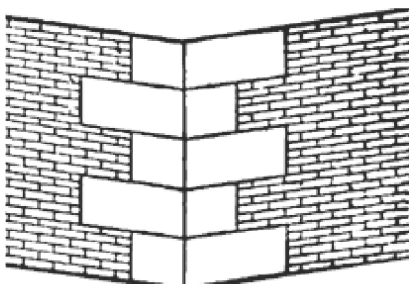
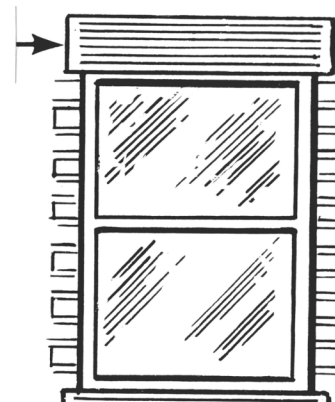
newel: a vertical post that supports a staircase's railing



tracery: narrow bars of stone that support the glass in a Gothic window



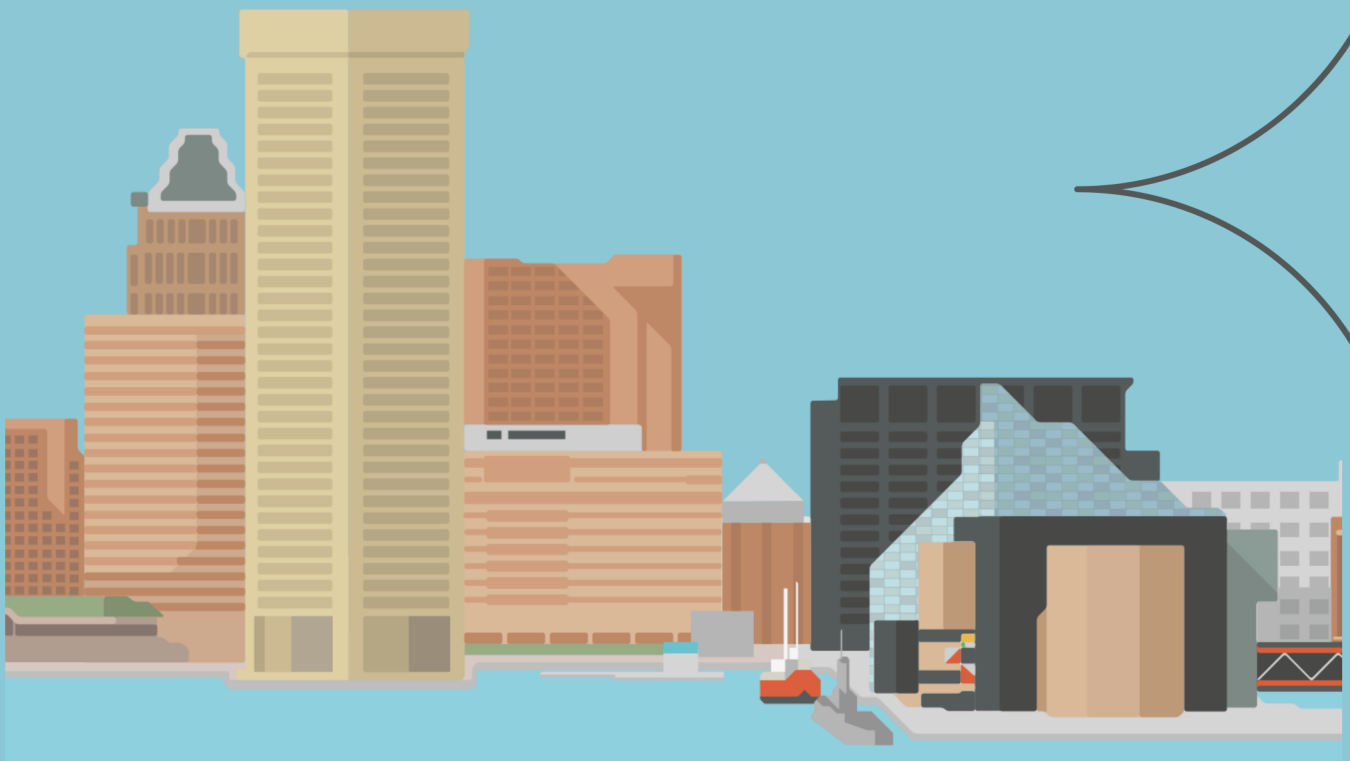
lintel: a horizontal beam supporting the weight above a door or window opening



quoins: decorative rectangles of stone or brick placed at the corners of a building
